

## Purpose

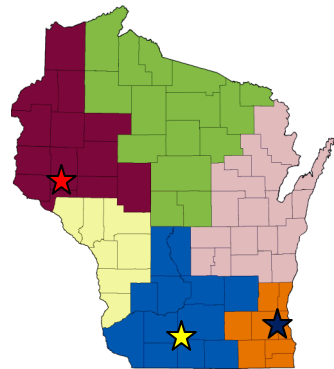
Strengthen the public health nursing workforce and improve the quality of public health nursing practice in a changing public health system.

## Overarching goal

Contribute to population health improvement and the reduction of health disparities by developing a sufficient, skilled, diverse and visible public health nursing workforce in Wisconsin.

## Regional learning collaboratives (RLCs)

- Six statewide RLCs comprised of teams of faculty, public health nurses (PHNs), tribal health nurses and school nurses.
- Provide linkages for collaboration on best and promising practices to advance public health nurse competency levels.
- Design, implement and evaluate models for population-based clinical field experiences for undergraduate and graduate level nursing students.
- Facilitated by three education practice liaisons positioned to serve statewide regions

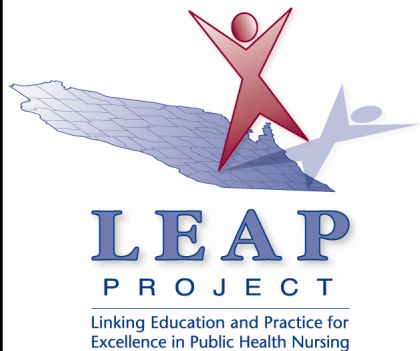
